Important Please make sure that if you enter internationally that the qualifications for you and your horse are correct, these should be sent with your entry to your FN.

The OC also need: your Email address, the OC can then confirm your entry,
send you important information and
time schedule
your mobile Nr., in case of emergencies

All horses that take part in international competitions **must** be stabled at **night** for the time of the competition (stable closing times will be announced nearer the event). The costs for stabling are **100.00 €** (this includes straw/shavings and MCP fee). This fee must be paid when the entries are made. Closing date for entries. **16.04.2010**

For competitors and horses arriving from **outside** Germany, please make sure that you have the appropriate travelling papers and health certificates for your horse with you. These will probably be controlled by the local state veterinarian. If you do not have the appropriate papers, this could lead to difficulties with the German State Veterinarians. Please see that these papers are kept with the FEI Passport.

Only one crew car per rider will be allowed to go round the course. No cars are allowed in the Vet-gate area. Cars must be parked in the car park..

Hotel and room-bookings can be made through the OC.

Dogs are allowed in the hotels that have been booked, they may charge a small fee per dog/per night. Dogs must be kept on a lead during the event.

Catering is available as from Friday midday, a breakfast buffet will also be available on all competition days.

The Pre-ride Briefing for the international and national rides is at the Gestütshof St Johann

All competitors will be given a time-table of the event with the sequence of loops that should be ridden, a set of maps in colour and a road book for the crew. All competitors will receive a stall plaque..
